Then, this week I would like you to present the results that you found.



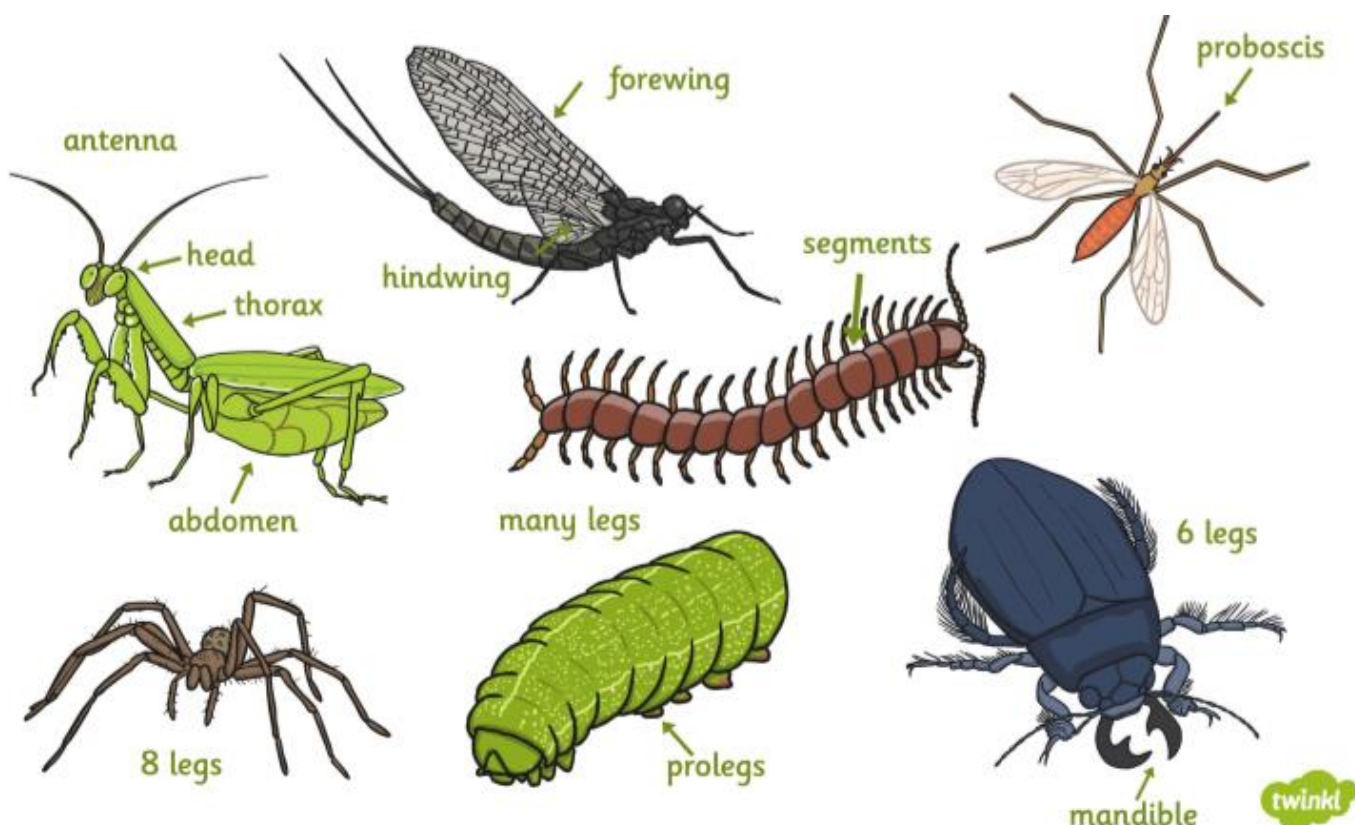
Did you find out an answer to your question?
