Seething is now NUT FREE!

Please can I remind you that Seething is a **NUT FREE SCHOOL**, and as such anything you send in packed lunches should not 'contain nuts' or 'may contain' nuts. Examples include:



- Packets of nuts
- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Fruit or cereal bars that contain nuts
- Hazelnut spread i.e. Nutella
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- Cakes with nuts.

As of September, we will have a pupil with a nut allergy and such foodstuffs may cause that child to suffer an anaphylactic reaction, requiring immediate medical treatment and/or hospitalisation. In due course we will issue a policy which outlines clearly what can and cannot be brought into school.
