Some 18 months ago, just before the COVID pandemic took hold, we were nominated for a prestigious award – the World Class School award. This award is held by only a few schools in the UK, including Sapientia Education school Wymondham College – the only other Norfolk school.

Over the last year, myself, Miss Squirrell and Mr Chahal have worked through a rigorous accreditation process which has examined many facets of school life, this culminated in a project led by three of our year 6 pupils (Darci-Rose Sayer, Imogen Bailey and Noah Davies), and assisted by Mr Chahal and Miss Squirrell.
